The Lookout Café is situated at Gara Rock and manager Richard Collins explained: 'When the hotel closed it was a huge loss to walkers enjoying the coastal path. Developers are now working on the new Gara Rock site but they were keen to reinstate something in the area for walkers and people enjoying the beach.' The Gara Rock site will open their own restaurant from Easter next year but until that time the Lookout Café will offer a range of food and drink and that often much-needed toilet stop for

everyone enjoying the coastline.

The Lookout Café will be open from July 1 until September 19 from 10am seven days a week. With open air seating for 50 you will be sure to enjoy a relaxed atmosphere, giving you the chance to fully appreciate your surroundings. Tea, coffee and cold drinks will be available throughout the day as well as a range of breakfast baps in the morning, gourmet sandwiches such as Salcombe Smokies with crème fraiche and lemon for lunch and then of course traditional cream teas throughout the afternoon. Produce will be locally sourced so you can be sure of great quality ingredients. Of course ice cream is a must as well!

Luckily it is not

only walkers who can enjoy this new venue as there is also a car park where you can leave your car and enjoy a short walk to Rickham Sands where the Lookout Café hopes to establish a beach service, selling ice creams and cold drinks. Throughout the summer season the Devon Air Ambulance will benefit from donations raised by Richard and his team at the café and it is hoped that in excess of £3,000 will be given to this important charity.

Walking parties are welcome and can be catered for, call Richard on 07769 906268 for more information or to book your refreshments in advance.

Richard has plenty of experience in the trade, working at the Millbrook Inn in South Pool after working in the previous Gara Rock Hotel. He explained that his family had been frequent visitors to Gara Rock since the 1970s and believes that Gara Rock is a truly special place to be.
